Healing Pathway Phase 2

Where Two or More Gather

is one of two parts of Phase 2 in the Healing Pathway program. It includes learning surface anatomy of the neck and back and practising specific healing sequences for these areas. Other aspects covered include the experience of group healing and support for the Practitioner's growth toward wholeness. Emphasis is on the development of self as an instrument of healing. Phase 1 is a pre-requisite. The workshop includes the following:

Content

- Learning about the surface anatomy of the neck and back
- Exploring the body, mind and soul connections to the back and the neck
- Learning and practising specific techniques and healing sequences for the neck, back, and head
- Learning and practising the Sacred Cross technique
- Learning and practising the basics of group healing
- Discussion of the practitioner's self-care and growth towards wholeness
- Reviewing and discussing the Code of Ethics
